Financial Aid applications for the 2018-2019 school term

FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment will be conducting the financial need analysis for Holy Family Regional Catholic School for the upcoming 2018-2019 school year. Families applying for financial aid will need to complete an application and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. The Archdiocese has established a preferred Priority Application deadline of **December 31, 2017**.

Since our school already uses FACTS for tuition collection the process should be convenient. Applicants can apply online by signing into their FACTS account and clicking the "Start Application" located in the FACTS Grant & Aid box on the right-hand side of your home page. (a screen shot is attached)

The FACTS link on the school's website at www.hfrcs.org can also be used to start an application. For convenience, the link is also included in an attachment below.

More information on the process is also provided in the attached flyer and video.

Once an online application has been completed, the following supporting documentation will need to be sent to FACTS to complete the application process by **March 15, 2018**:

- Copies of your **2017 Federal tax forms** including all supporting tax schedules. (2016 return is not needed)
- Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and TANF.
