A Note from the Principals

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Happy New Year!

Now that it's January, it is a good time to review school closing/delayed opening procedures in the event of inclement weather.

The decision to delay the opening of school or to close altogether, is determined by the status of bus transportation, primarily Bristol Township buses. While the school is located in Neshaminy School District, the majority of our students reside in Bristol Township. During a bad weather event, if <u>Bristol Township</u> announces that schools are closed, or will have a delayed opening, we follow suit. Our families are notified in a number of ways: text, email, Facebook, announcements through WPVI 6, NBC10, and our web-site.

If school is in session and we must close early due to inclement weather, you will be notified in the same way. Please do not call the school! We need to keep the lines open to receive calls from transportation companies so that students can be dismissed at the appropriate times. If school closes early, CARES will not be operating. Please have the conversation with your child about what to do and where to go, should school close early.

We will have our First Friday Mass on January 6 at 8:30 A.M. All are welcome.






