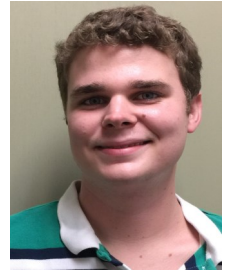

# Important Information!

**School Hours:** The school day starts for students in K-8 at 7:55am each day; please make every effort to have your child arrive to school on time so that they can put their best foot forward each day! PreK students need to arrive by 8:10am, but are welcome to arrive beginning at 7:40 each day. All students benefit from arriving to school early!!



**Parking Lot Safety:** Please use caution and patience when entering and exiting our parking lot and be aware that this space is shared with Queen of the Universe Parish. **Handicapped parking rules are applicable at all times!!**

**COVID Information:** If your child is staying home due to contracting COVID or a possible exposure, it is **VERY IMPORTANT** that you contact your child’s homeroom teacher, Mrs. McKnight (our school nurse), Mrs. Haggerty and Mrs. St. John.



**Uniform Reminder:** We are now in Winter Uniforms; **shorts may not be worn with the regular or gym uniforms!** School policy states that students may wear black school shoes or plain black sneakers (no embellishments). Please be sure that your child is wearing proper shoes each day. **Only school hoodie may be worn with gym uniform!**



**Birthday Treats:** We will continue to celebrate our student’s birthdays, here at school! Please consider sending in a small individually wrapped item, such as a pencil in a Ziploc bag, for your child to share on his/her birthday. You may want to consider donating a book for the classroom library! Thank you for understanding that we are no longer permitted to share food items in our classrooms.



**Masks/Gaiters:** Our students are doing a great job coming to school wearing a mask/gaiter; thank you!! Please be sure to check that your child’s mask/gaiter fits well; face masks/gaiters need to cover the nose and mouth at all times. Gaiters need to be lined.



**STREAM:** Due to Covid-19, our STREAM days have been put on hold for the foreseeable future. The purpose of STREAM is to have our students and classes work collaboratively and this is not possible with our current social distancing guidelines.

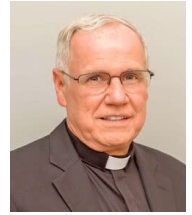
