PURPOSE of the DLFF PATHWAY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- To encourage the K-12 pathway for parents choosing Catholic education.
- To acknowledge the whole student with a focus on encouraging academic potential, qualities of initiative, responsibility, accountability, leadership and service both in and out of school.
- To present CEC as an excellent educational option for students continuing the pathway of Catholic education.

PATHWAY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM DETAILS

- Award amount: \$1,000/year
- Eligibility: Students entering 6th-8th grade at participating schools.
- Award is renewable through 8th grade.
- Award is offered based on application process and elementary school team review/selection.
- Award is not transferable to another Catholic elementary school.



CURRENT PATHWAY SCHOLARS

- DLFF will reach out to faculty members of current scholars twice a year for completion of a brief Progress Monitoring Form. Forms for current scholars will be emailed to teachers by early December. We ask that you please complete these by the end of January and the end of April. PATHWAY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS FOR THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

- Application will be sent from DLFF to participating schools for suggested posting on school website and optional printed version for families.
- Eligible families/students will complete and submit application to current grade level teacher of their choice for completion of the **Faculty Input Form** by **4/3/2020**.
- For the **Faculty Input Form**, we ask that teachers consider the whole student and their potential in the areas of school participation, leadership qualities, academic potential, responsibility and eagerness to serve his/her community.
- Teacher will submit the completed application with **Faculty Input Form** to the designated school Principal by **4/15/2020**.
- Each participating school's scholarship review team will process applications and make selections based on the above qualities, as well as collaborative and respectful effort in the classroom and financial need while considering the DLFF approach of acknowledging the whole student.
- The School Administrator will notify DLFF of the Pathway Elementary School Scholarship recipients by **5/1/2020**. The Administrator will email the recipient list along with a copy of all applications to (Sue@DLFF.org)
- Awards to be announced in May 2020.
