<u>Referral Program</u>

As we enter the enrollment season for next school year, we would like to remind our families of Holy Family's New Student Referral Program. This program awards a referring Holy Family Regional Catholic School family with a tuition credit as our way of saying thank you for your trust and confidence in our school.

For referring a new family to Holy Family Regional, the current HFRCS family will receive an incentive payment of \$200 off their child's tuition. The referring family must have a child enrolled/attending Holy Family Regional.

Please note that there is no limit as to how many times a HFRCS family can use the New Student Referral Program. So please encourage all of your friends and family members who are looking for a new school to apply to Holy Family today!

<u>COVID Information</u>: If your child is staying home due to contracting COVID or a possible exposure, it is <u>VERY IMPORTANT</u> that you contact your child's homeroom teacher, Mrs. McKnight (our school nurse), Mrs. Haggerty and Mrs. St. John.
