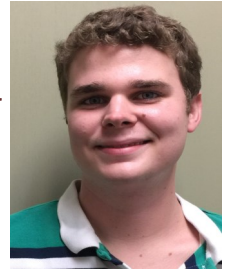
Advice to HF Students

# Important Information!



**COVID Information:** If your child is staying home due to contracting COVID or a possible exposure, it is VERY IMPORTANT that you contact your child’s homeroom teacher, Mrs. McKnight (our school nurse), Mrs. Haggerty and Mrs. St. John.
