School Hours: The school day starts for students in K-8 at 7:55am each day; please make every effort to have your child arrive to school on time so that they can put their best foot forward each day! PreK students need to arrive by 8:10am, but are welcome to arrive beginning at 7:40 each day. All students benefit from arriving to school early!!

<u>Parking Lot Safety:</u> Please use caution and patience when entering and exiting our parking lot and be aware that this space is shared with Queen of the Universe Parish. <u>Handicapped parking rules are applicable at all times!!</u>

<u>COVID Information:</u> If your child is staying home due to contracting COVID or a possible exposure, it is <u>VERY IMPORTANT</u> that you contact your child's homeroom teacher, Mrs. McKnight (our school nurse), Mrs. Haggerty and Mrs. St. John.
