A Note from the Principals

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Christmas came early to HFRCS!

Last week we received a letter from the Connelly Foundation announcing that our school was selected to receive a grant that would fund a technology package. Specifically, we were being granted 30 Dell Chromebooks with Google EDU Management Console Licenses, as well as a cart for storage and charging.

Why did we receive this technology grant? The letter from the Connelly Foundation stated that our school was being recognized "for [our] demonstrated commitment to using the Google Apps for Education/Google Suite, and building a 1:1 environment for [our] students."

We had already placed the order for Chromebooks for the 6th through the 8th grades. This addition of 30 Chromebooks to our technology hardware will enable us to provide a 1:1 tech experience (i.e., one device, either Chromebook or iPad for each child) from 8th down through 1st grade! Kindergarten will have a cart of iPads available for their use.

We are grateful to the Connelly Foundation and all benefactors of our Holy Family Fund,. Their contributions have allowed us to expand learning opportunities for our students.






HFRCS PRESENTS A NIGHT OF COMEDY
