Thank you to everyone who sent in donations! We had a 67% participation rate and ended at 72% of our goal of \$20,000. The total amount raised was \$14,535.82. Our 2 classrooms with the highest average per student are

Advent: A Time of Preparation

In the Catholic Church, Advent is a period of preparation, extending over four Sundays, before Christmas. The word *Advent* comes from the Latin *advenio*, "to come to," and refers to the coming of Christ. This refers, first of all, to our celebration of Christ's birth at Christmas; but second, to the coming of Christ in our lives through grace and the Sacrament of Holy Communion; and finally, to His Second Coming at the end of time.

Our preparations, therefore, should have all three comings in mind. We need to prepare our souls to receive Christ worthily.





- **Grades PK3- 3** will be collecting hats and mittens (both child and adult sizes) that will be sent to either St. Vincent de Paul shelter or Mother Bachmann Center.
- **Grades 4-8** will be collecting items to be put in "Stockings for Soldiers". HFRCS will be sending the stockings to young soldiers called the "Guardian Angels" who have been recently deployed. Some suggestions on what to include in the stockings are below.
 - Gum, hard candy, small toothbrush /toothpaste, small packs of tissues, comb, travel size shampoo and conditioner, small Sudoku and crossword puzzles, nail clipper set, hand lotion, dental floss, socks, etc.
- Anything you contribute is greatly appreciated. All hats, mittens and stocking items are due by **Thursday**, **December 15th**.
- Beginning the week of **December 5th**, every Monday will be an "*Advent Color Day*". Students may wear the color of what week it is during the season. For example, bracelets, headbands, socks, etc. Students **MUST** still wear their winter uniforms but can wear accessories of the Advent color of the week.

 - Monday, December 19th Purple
- Each homeroom will also be collecting items for their grandparent over at Statesman to make a basket for Christmas. We are asking for items similar to what has been donated in the past. Anything you can donate is greatly appreciated! We will be collecting items until Friday, December 16th.
