From the Principal's Office

As we move now into our fifth full week of school, we are reminded to continually be vigilant with our safety protocols. Mask wearing, staying as socially distant as possible and maintaining proper hand hygiene remain our best line of defense. Please also remember the following:

- If any member of your immediate family is getting tested for COVID-19, please do not send your child to school until the test results come back. If the test is negative, the child may return to school the next day. If positive, the child must stay home for two weeks and be a virtual learner.
- If your family or members of your immediate family are traveling outside of Pennsylvania to a state/country that requires a two-week quarantine, your child must stay home for the duration of that quarantine and be a virtual learner.
- For student devices (grades 3-8) to be taken out of the building for virtual learning, proof of device insurance must be sent to school. The window for obtaining that insurance is this week only! **The window closes on Friday, October 16th and cannot be extended.** Due to the uncertainty of anyone's situation, it is strongly recommended that everyone take advantage of this opportunity. - Morning drop off and afternoon carline have been restructured this year for everyone's safety. Please follow the proper procedures and be patient as we work to provide the most efficient entry and exit plans for our students.

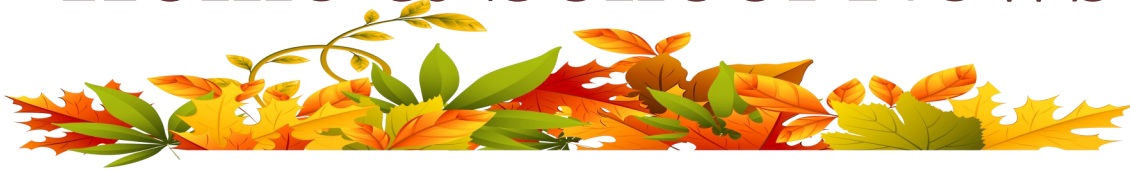

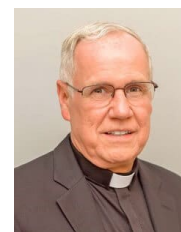
