Award recipients will be selected by an appointed scholarship review team at each individual school.

Award recipients will be notified in May 2021.

Please note that the DLFF Pathway Elementary School Scholarship Program is individually managed by each participating school and therefore the award is not transferable to another elementary school. This \$1,000 scholarship will be a renewable award through 8th grade as long as the student maintains good academic and financial standing.
