- Share your completed application with a current teacher and request their recommendation in the faculty input section by Friday, 3/31/2023
- Teachers will need to submit completed applications to your school Principal by Friday, 4/14/2023

Award recipients will be selected by an appointed scholarship review team at each individual school.

Award recipients will be notified by the Principal of each school in May 2023.

Please note that the DLFF Pathway Elementary School Scholarship Program is individually managed by each participating school and therefore the award *is not transferable* to another elementary school. This \$1,000 scholarship will be a renewable award through 8th grade as long as the student maintains good academic and financial standing.

The Pathway Scholarship is a distinct award program - separate from the DLFF/CEC Scholarship application process. A Pathway Scholarship awarded does not guarantee the selection of a DLFF/CEC Scholarship.
