From the Principal's Office

You may have noticed that our arrival and dismissal times have been temporarily adjusted to help with the flow of traffic in our car line. In the next few weeks, we will be adjusting our times to get back to opening our doors each morning at 7:40am and beginning dismissal at 2:50pm. Our goal is to have our students benefit from a full instructional day.

Listed below are suggestions to help both the morning and afternoon car lines move efficiently:

Morning Drop-off

- Students should be ready to get out of the car; this includes having mask in place, jacket on, book bag and lunch within reach.
- If the morning timeline does not fit your schedule, please consider sending your child to our [CARES program](#), which begins at 7am.

Afternoon Dismissal

- **Please be sure to clearly communicate with your child's teacher and the main office if you are changing the way your child will be dismissed.**
- Please place your family number in **front passenger window of your car**. It is very helpful for our students and staff to see the number displayed.
- When you get to front of the car line, please get out of your car, wearing a mask, so that your child can see you. We have found that dismissal goes much faster when your child can see you vs. trying to recognize your car in the dismissal setting.

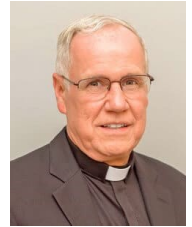
