Important Information!

Busing: We will email bus stop lists to all families as soon as bus information is becomes available.

Nicky Folder Pickup: Folders will be available for pickup tonight (9/2) and tomorrow evening (9/3) from 5-7:30. It was great to see/meet parents who came by last night!

Book/Material Pickup: Books/material pickup for our virtual students will take place on Tuesday, September 8th and Wednesday, September 9th from 4-7pm.
