
Welcome to the 2020-2021 school year! As we get ready to begin this uncertain year, we are prepared to **F.E.E.D.** our students:

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Covid-19 FAQs

Based on what we know as of August 12, 2020

Bussing: School districts are still making decisions regarding bussing nonpublic school students. We will share this information when we receive it.

<u>Mask wearing/heat:</u> Students will be required to wear a mask in school. We will be providing mask breaks during the day. Holy Family masks are not a required part of the school uniform but rather an option for families. Students will begin wearing the summer uniform and this may be extended, if needed, into the fall, to assist in student comfort.

<u>Tuition:</u> There will be no reduction in tuition for virtual learning. Teachers are still teaching, now both virtually and in person. The school is also responsible for providing the equipment needed for live streaming instruction.

<u>Movement:</u> We will be trying to reduce movement throughout the building. Special subject teachers will be "pushing in" to classrooms for their classes or possibly teaching remotely to students with Chromebooks. We hope to implement a middle school schedule that will encourage larger blocks of learning to decrease constant class changing while still providing the required time of instruction. For longer periods of instruction and in general, teachers will offer brain breaks to alleviate stress. This will look different at each grade level.

Honors Math: Students who are a part of the Honors Math program will continue to go to Honors Math for their math instruction.

<u>Lunch/Recess</u>: Lunch will be eaten in the classroom. Student swill still have access to our free lunch and breakfast program. Students will have outdoor recess but will stay within their cohort (homeroom). Designated outdoor space will be assigned and the cohorts can rotate through the spaces, e.g. field, playground, blacktop.

Physical Education: Students will still have PE class. We will utilize the outdoors as much as possible and will provide social distancing and the sanitizing of equipment after each class. Gym Uniforms will be required.

<u>Survey Choice</u>: Parents who responded to one particular learning modality in the survey will not be held to this. We will send another form out closer to the start of school for you to indicate your decision for the month of September. Parents will have the option to change their decision monthly.

<u>Classroom movement and socialization:</u> Because masks will be worn, they will be able to move in the classroom, but there will be no material sharing and more restrictions on group activities. It is our goal to keep the learning day as routine as possible.

<u>Academic activities/traditions:</u> We hope to continue all of our academic learning activities and traditions, though they may look different for this year. We must think outside the box to continue special learning activities in a way that ensures student and teacher safety.

<u>CARES</u>: We realize that providing a before and after school program is essential to some of our families. CARES will observe all of the distancing and sanitation observances we will be using in the classroom and the hall will be oriented to provide space that affords distancing for all students.

Nurse: Holy Family Regional provides a full-time nurse for our students and will continue to have a full-time nurse next year.

Enrollment: We are getting frequent inquiries from parents outside of our school community. We are looking at this on a case by case basis and are considering our current class size in our decision making. We are always interested in growing our Holy Family school community but will not jeopardize the safety and well being of our current students.
