School Improvement Survey

Thank you to all our parents and guardians who responded to the Archdiocesan School Improvement Survey. We had 128 responses, 90 from pre-K through 4th grade, and 38 from 5th through 8th grade. That represents 44% of families who responded. According to the people who conduct these surveys, that's a good response.

Respondents were asked to rate each performance area using a range from 1 to 5. The scores for each category ranged from optimal to areas of concern. See the chart below for an explanation.

Optimal performance	Scores >=4.5
Approaching optimal performance	Scores >3.75
Areas of opportunity	Scores >3 and <3.75
Areas of concern	Scores <3
