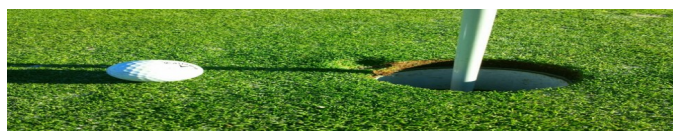
We will be selling Sweet Spot Hole in One Donuts from May 15th until May 25th.

Joseph Dettore - qualified in the 200 meter

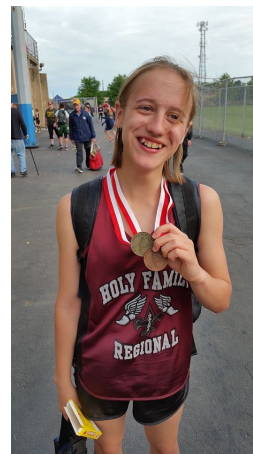
Joey Gottshall - 6th in the 100, 4th in the 200 and qualified for the Shot Put.
